On Wednesday, April 16th at 4:30 pm, Wellesley will hold a Gathering of Remembrance on the Chapel lawn for students, faculty and staff during which we will remember those who lost their lives through violence at Virginia Tech, as well as remembering those whom we have known at Wellesley and in our lives outside of Wellesley who have died.

Members of the community are invited to bring poems, prayers, and their own reflections to share with one another. There will be opportunities to remember loved ones through making paper prayer chains and also opportunities for those who choose, to take action against violence (particularly gun violence) by participating in a movement "ProtestEasyGuns.com" started by a Wellesley alumna, Abby Spangler.

Together with Abby, we will be joining colleges and universities across the country by pausing on this day to remember the Virginia Tech shootings and also considering the causes of such violence.
